<u>Update on the Synod</u>: This phase of the Synod on Synodality has finished in Rome. The conclusion of this phase produced a summary document indicating some of the topics discussed and the need for further studies as we create a more welcoming and open Church community. The main topics of the Synod are: Communion, Participation, and Mission and how these relate to our life in the Church. Pope Francis asked the participants to reflect on their discussions and to prepare for the final phase of the Synod next October 2024. Bishops throughout the world will be sent a summary of the topics shared and there will be some further consultation and sharing for the next phase. Pope Francis did not make any statements on changes in the Church or in Catholic Church practice but asked that the dialogue continue with the help of the Holy Spirit.

<u>All Souls Day and All Saints Day</u>: As we celebrate these important feast days on November 1st and 2nd, we join in prayer with the Saints in recognizing that we are one family in faith and that the Saints pray with us in giving glory to God. On All Souls Day, we remember all those who have died and are awaiting the final resurrection. We especially remember our loved ones and friends, that God will bring them into His eternal kingdom.
