National Day of Prayer: On December 12, 2020, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, we celebrate the National Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples in Canada. The theme for this year is: "Healing of the Earth." Indigenous people around our world have their creation stories. These stories are about relationships. They teach us about the Earth and it's awakening. God the Creator makes the Earth a good place. He sees a beautiful place with purpose. We acknowledge God as the Creator of all things! Together we share one common home, Mother Earth, and we are all dependant on her for our existence.
