<u>Synod on Synodality</u>: This meeting, the XVI meeting of the Synod of Bishops, is now being held in Rome for the next month. The clergy and lay people attending the synod, are discussing the reports given by each country of the world, on the questions and responses from the shared meetings held in many parishes over the last year. The report from Canada can be found on the national bishop's website (<u>www.cccb.ca</u>) under Synodal Summary for Canada. These meetings and discussions, encouraged and lead by Pope Francis, are to assist the Holy Father in guiding the Catholic Church in the world. Events about the development of topics and discussions can be found on the synod and for its success.

Bishops of Canada Meetings: Bishop Colli has just returned from meetings with the bishops of Canada and the bishops of Ontario. Highlights from the meetings included a look at the Synod for Synodality and a report from the bishops in Rome from Canada at the Synod along with lay people. Also, the bishops discussed our on-going Truth and Reconciliation programs in dioceses and the effect of the visit from Pope Francis in Canada and our Indigenous peoples. The Ontario bishops discussed our Catholic Schools and their progress and special ministries for lay people in our churches. Special celebrations will be held in Quebec City in 2024 as they celebrate the 350th Anniversary of the Catholic Church in Canada.
