Pope Francis accepted the resignation of Bishop Colli as the Bishop of Thunder Bay on **June 17, 2024**, having reached his 75th birthday, as Church law requires. A new bishop will be assigned in the near future, and in the interim period a Diocesan Administrator will act for the diocese. After 25 years of service, Bishop Colli's final Mass in Thunder Bay will be on **July 14, 2024** at St. Patrick's Cathedral at 10:30 am. A small reception for him will be held immediately after Mass and a formal reception will take place at the Diocesan Pastoral Centre on Reaume St. from 2-5 pm. that afternoon. Everyone is welcome.
