Pope Francis accepted the resignation of Bishop Colli as the Bishop of Thunder Bay on June 17, 2024, having reached his 75th birthday, as Church law requires. A new bishop will be assigned in the near future, and in the interim period a Diocesan Administrator will act for the diocese. After 25 years of service, Bishop Colli's final Mass in Thunder Bay will be on July 14, 2024 at St. Patrick's Cathedral at 10:30 am. A small reception for him will be held immediately after Mass and a formal reception will take place at the Diocesan Pastoral Centre on Reaume St. from 2-5 pm. that afternoon. Everyone is welcome.
