<u>THE ROMAN CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF THUNDER BAY HAS A NEW BISHOP:</u> After much prayer and anticipation, the Diocese of Thunder Bay is happy to announce that Rev. Alan Campeau has been named by Pope Francis as the Bishop of Thunder Bay.

Father Campeau is presently the pastor of St. Joseph parish in Dryden, Immaculate Conception parish in Ignace and Our Lady of Fatima parish in Vermilion Bay.

He is following the leadership of Bishop Fred Colli who was the bishop of the diocese for twenty-five years and retired at the end of June of 2024.

Bishop Elect Campeau will be consecrated Bishop and installed as Bishop of the Diocese of Thunder Bay on Thursday February 27, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. at St. Patrick's Cathedral, Thunder Bay
